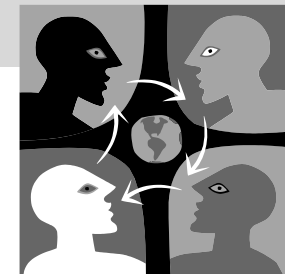

# Introduction

The Oklahoma Society for Psychoanalytic Studies (OSPS) is presenting a One Year Course in Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy. This course will occur on a weekly basis, Fridays from 1:00pm – 4:00pm, for a total of thirty–four weeks throughout the academic year of 2009–2010, September through May. Each week’s time will be divided equally between didactic courses and case conference. The course work will be divided into four sections. The first section, The History of Psychoanalytic Ideas, will take place over the first four weeks and will represent an overview of the entire one year course. The other three sections will include Conflict Theory (ten weeks), Object Relations Theory (ten weeks), and Relational Theory (ten weeks). During the first four week section Case Conference will be comprised of case presentations by the faculty. During the subsequent sections students will present their cases to the faculty leader(s) and other students. The Case Conference faculty member’s orientation will roughly correspond to the section being presented. One or more Case Conference groups may be offered to each section. Attempts will be made to make the Case Conference group as small and intimate as possible.
